To sign up for the Online Learning Centre, go to: <https://ohsregistration.phsa.ca/>.

Be sure to use a valid email address that is specifically yours, as you will not be able to receive your account information if you do not. If you are using a health authority email address, the email structure for Fraser Health, Interior Health, VIHA and VCH is: `firstname.lastname@healthauthorityname.ca`, i.e. jane.smith@northernhealth.ca. Your email address would NOT be jsmith@northernhealth.ca or janesmith@northernhealth.ca.
